Bonneville Power Administration's Division of Fish and Wildlife (F&W) is undergoing changes in its contracting practices and is offering a workshop for project managers and their administrative staff to discuss these changes and how they affect project sponsors. BPA accounting staff will be on hand to explain the proposed new procedures. In addition, BPA staff will answer questions about recent changes in BPA's contracting policies and procedures. Agenda items include fiscal year accrual estimates and limits, stop work/termination clauses, and written authorizations. BPA staff will discuss changes being considered for FY04, such as multi-year contracting. Finally, time will be available for participants to ask questions and discuss proposed changes.
