- Document requests for rescheduling, within-year modifications, and related requests received by April 7. No actions will be taken at this meeting.
- Explain the process for developing FY 2005 budgets.
- Consider Within-Year Modification Requests that do not involve requests for increased budgets.
- Compare FY 2004 budgets to actual spending - identify projects that appear to be slow in implementing approved FY 2004 work.
