3.0 Description

The Digital Raster Graphic (DRG) is a raster image of a scanned USGS 1:100,000 scale topographic map including the collar information, georeferenced to the local UTM grid.


The 100K DRG is a convenient background for point, line, and polygon themes of medium size watersheds. DRG map symbols and text is often legible and well proportioned in printed GIS map products. Textual data and line work in the DRG orient viewers to project specific data. USGS mapping symbols are familiar so usually need little supplemental explanation. Aerial photo derived information in DRG's may be 20 or 30 years old.
